One outlandish scheme follows another as they try to leave a hotel without paying the bill. Ably assisting them are Lucille Ball and Ann Miller.

At a time when it is difficult to find screen entertainment for the whole family THE CLASSIC COMEDIANS is a wonderful opportunity to "get away from it all" and enjoy honest belly laughs.
