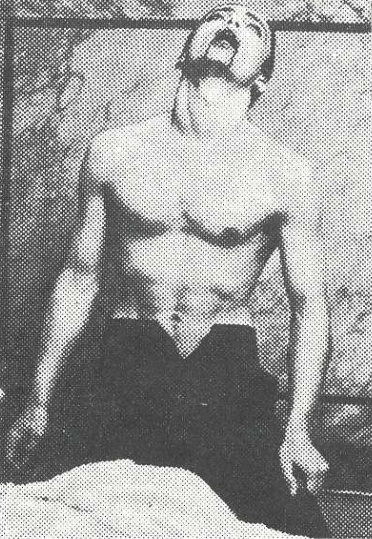

"ZANDY'S BRIDE"


