Emerson Lake & Palmer in concert. An Albuquerque film premier.

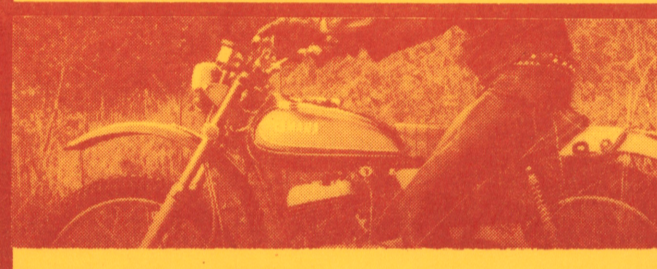
