The resulting film contains the most beautiful footage ever taken in the Himalayas and the highest cinematography shooting in history.

Lina Wertmuller's
Seven Beauties

This movie has ended more unqualified rave reviews and flattering comparisons to the best of cinematic history than any film in recent memory. Giancarlo Giannini is cast as a man struggling for survival behind German lines during WW II. The theme is human ideals vs. the instinct for self preservation. Wertmuller's best to date; and following Seduction of Mimi, Love & Anarchy and Swept Away, that's quite a statement.

Hester Street is a genuinely touching tale of Jewish immigrants in New York at the turn of the century, focusing on an upwardly mobile young man who fears that his assimilation into the American mainstream is threatened when his dowdy wife suddenly arrives from the old country. Excellent performances, fine period recreation and a canny mixture of wry humor and tender pathos.

Bergman may hold out little hope for the uncompromised happiness of his characters, but there's at least some solace in his ultimate faith in the resiliency of the human spirit.
