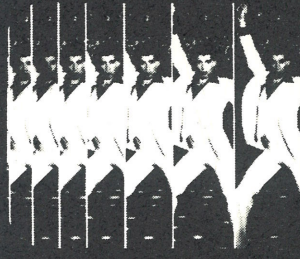

The Union Film Theatre is located on the University of New Mexico campus, in the lower south level of the Student Union Building. Enter via the outside staircase at the south end of the building.



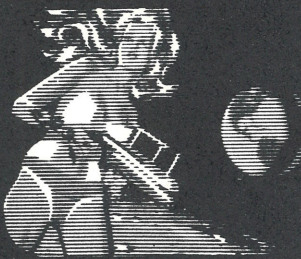
JUNE

- Sat. 16 **LAST TANGO IN PARIS.** Bernardo Bertolucci directs Marlon Brando and Maria Schneider in one of the most powerfully erotic movies ever made. This penetrating essay on human nature is a genuine masterpiece of staggering proportions.
- Fri. 22 **BLAZING SADDLES.** Directed by Mel Brooks and starring Gene Wilder and Cleavon Little, this is the most uproarious and side splitting parody of the "Western" ever made.
- Sat. 23 **SHAMPOO.** Warren Beatty, Goldie Hawn, Julie Christie and Lee Grant star in this outrageous and witty sexual-farce which has been called the most successful American comedy in years.
